

Outstanding Conservation Cooperator Of the Year Award: 2025

Purpose and Eligibility

The purpose of the Conservation Cooperator of the Year Award is to recognize the outstanding landowners who are taking the initiative to implement sound, innovative and cost-effective conservation techniques, and best management practices.

Nominee must be a "Master Conservationist" and the application submitted by their local conservation district. The district shall provide the proper requested criteria for the total farming operation. This includes livestock, and property that is owned, rented, or operated by the nominee.

Previous state winners of the Outstanding Conservation Cooperator of the Year Award are not eligible for consideration.

Entry Procedure:

Entry must be submitted to KADC by the Local Conservation District. Documentation of the cooperators work, based on the judging criteria, may be sent electronically via email to: Crystal.Renfro.KACD@outlook.com. All documentation should be limited to 10 pages and divided into sections according to the standard criteria. **Please use this form as the cover of your application.**

Recognition

Outstanding Cooperator of the Year Award winner and runner-up will be recognized on the state level by the Kentucky Association of Conservation Districts at their 2025 Annual Meeting in Louisville, KY.

The state winner and runner-up will receive a certificate and cash award to be used by the cooperator as they see appropriate. In addition, the local conservation district of the winner and runner-up will receive a plaque.

- 3) To what extent has the nominee's farm operation been used to demonstrate to other members of the community the problems and solutions associated with soil and water conservation?
- 4) Describe areas where the nominee has used their own initiative to develop other resources such as wildlife, woodland or techniques developed by the nominee to implement conservation practices.
- 5) Summarize why this individual her been nominated.
- 6) Please include any pictures that you feel will assist in the judges understanding their operation in relation to the conservation of natural resources.
